## Allegany County Solid Waste 2018 Fees for Residents

**Residential Permit Fees (Cash, Check, Credit Card)**

Residential Hang Tag (April 1– March 31) (Tags are non-transferable)	\$200/Year
Lost Hang Tag Fee	\$100
Disposal Tickets (Pay per Bag)	\$10 / \$20 / \$30
Price Per Bag:	
13 gallon or smaller	\$1.00
30 gallon	\$3.00
55 gallon bag or barrel	\$5.00
Large Items (couch, mattress, etc...)	\$5.00
Small items (chair, table, sink, etc...)	\$4.00

**Other Residential Fees (Cash or Check only)**

Pay per Load (County Scales– Landfill Only)	\$50/Ton
Minimum Scale Fee for Weighing In	\$20
Construction & Demolition (C&D) Debris	\$50/Ton
- May dispose of small amounts on the Residential Hang Tag each visit to the Transfer Station. A small amount is equal to what the resident can physically carry from the vehicle to the hopper in one trip per day equal to a 55 gallon container.	
CFC (Freon) Containing Appliances (Landfill only)	\$10.00
*Doors must be removed from Refrigerators/Freezers	
White Goods- Washers, Dryers, Stoves, etc (Landfill Only)	No Charge
Weight Ticket for DMV Registration	\$5.00
Used Tire Disposal—Must be removed from rims (Landfill only)	
- Up to 20 Inch	\$ 2.50
-20 Inch to 24.5 Inch	\$15.00
-Larger then 24.5 Inch	\$200/Ton
-Tires up to 24.5 inch in loads of 20 or more	\$200/Ton

What to bring to E-Waste Events:

- ♻ Televisions of all types
- ♻ Computer Monitors of all types
- ♻ Computer Peripherals (any cable, cord, wiring or accessory that plugs into a computer)
- ♻ Small Electronic Equipment
- ♻ VCR's, DVR's, DVD Players
- ♻ Cable Boxes
- ♻ Digital Music Players
- ♻ Game Consoles
- ♻ Small Scale Servers

To participate in the events, County Residents will need to present up arrival any of the following:

1. Current Allegany County Solid Waste Residential Disposal Permit a.k.a. "Hang Tag" (or)
2. Allegany County Solid Waste Disposal Ticket a.k.a. "Mark Off Ticket" (or)
3. Allegany County Solid Waste Recycling Permit (Available free of charge to all County Residents)

\*Televisions are accepted the 1st Saturday of every month at the Wellsville Transfer Station

# Recycling Guidelines



## Paper

### Do Recycle:

Newspapers, magazines, paper, junk mail, envelopes, etc.

### Do Not Recycle:

Any paper product with wax or contaminated with food (please discard)



## Cardboard

### Do Recycle:

Cereal boxes, shoeboxes, corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags, etc.

### Do Not Recycle:

Padded mailing envelopes, detergent boxes, milk cartons, juice boxes, manila folders



## Plastic

### Do Recycle:

All plastic containers, bottles and jugs with #1 - #7 on the bottom including items such as— milk jugs, water bottles, laundry detergent, shampoo, yogurt and butter tubs. **All Containers should be clean with lids removed.**

### Do Not Recycle:

Styrofoam, plastic bags, food and candy wrappers, toys, non-containers



## Glass

### Do Recycle:

Recycle all glass containers, bottles, and jars that are Clear, Green and Brown

### Do Not Recycle:

Glass containing lead, such as auto glass and window glass cannot be recycled.



## Metal Cans

### Do Recycle:

Most metal cans we use everyday can be recycled. Recycle steel, tin and aluminum cans.

### Do Not Recycle:

Aerosol cans, aluminum foil, pie tins or trays

## Needle Disposal— Think Sharp

Proper disposal of medical syringes at home can prevent injury, illness and pollution. Allegany County DPW's Safe Syringe Program makes syringe disposal easy and safe. Residents can receive FREE individual Sharp Containers at any County Pharmacy or any County solid waste facility. Household Sharps should be disposed at one of the 8 drop boxes.

Residents can also bring sharps in approved containers to all transfer stations (give to operator). All free containers include an attached label with the disposal locations and a brochure describing safe handling of used needles.

## Household Hazardous Waste Day Scheduled for September

The Allegany County Department of Public Works is announcing their 19th annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day to be held September 8, 2018. The collection will be held from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon at the County Landfill in Belmont. Some of the items accepted include oil based paints, insecticides, poisons, pesticides, solvents and pool chemicals.

Pre-registration is required and only Allegany County residents can participate. Common household products with warning labels that read danger, poison and caution are considered potentially hazardous and should not be casually thrown in the garbage.
