TO REPLACE SALT BARN

At a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wellsville, New York held on July 24, 2017, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellsville Trustees has approved the 2017-2018 Annual budget which includes a Capital Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellsville, in discussion with the Department of Public Works, has deemed it necessary to replace the current "Salt Barn" for the General Fund based upon the inspection of the current facility, and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the Salt Barn, which will be shared with the Town of Wellsville, in an amount that shall not exceed Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000 Village Share) which shall be appropriated from the General Fund Capital Reserves, and

WHEREAS, this resolution is subject to permissive referendum per public notice which will be given through the official newspaper within 10 days and which would require 20% of the registered voters as of the last election to file a petition with the village clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wellsville does hereby authorize the replacement of the Salt Barn during this fiscal year if Village Trustees deem the plan and town cost sharing to be acceptable when identified.
