The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag led by Ms. Laura Landers.

Deputy Mayor Ketchner called the meeting to order at 4:34 pm and announced that the sole purpose of the meeting was to present reports related to the Village's audit of the regulatory financial statements for the year ending May 31, 2018.

Deputy Mayor Dawn Ketchner opened the floor to Laura Landers.

Ms. Landers thanked the Board for the 4:30pm meeting and the good weather. In addressing the Annual Audit Report, Ms. Landers began with a discussion on the financial statements, government-wide activities concerning all liabilities and assets, and a statement of activities. Ms. Landers spoke on unassigned funds and how they are used for whatever the Board finds they need to use them for; for example, to balance the budget.

Ms. Landers indicated the General Fund is in a stable financial position. She stated further that there were no new standards in the current year, or any changes to the prior year.

Also included in the report was a specific report to the Village Board. She indicated there were no audit adjustments or significant deficiencies. There were no significant matters to be included in the financial statements. Ms. Landers stated the Village is in an acceptable condition with regard to management and the financial statements. There were not any significant issues arising from the audit.

Ms. Landers noted the Justice bank account reconciliations are to be reviewed and initialed by the Justice.

Trustee Cole made a motion to accept the audit findings and Trustee Fahs seconded the motion. Carried.

The meeting adjourned at 5:26 pm on a motion made by Trustee Cole and seconded by Trustee Fahs. Carried.
