Village of Wellsville

Local Law No. 3 of the year 1999

A local law regulating Banners/Pennants/Advertising Matters

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the

Village of Wellsville as follows:

Section 3.1 POSTING PROHIBITED

No person shall post any handbills, notices or advertisements of any kind whatsoever, or print, paint, stamp or otherwise mark any words, letters, figures, signs or tokens, of any sort or kind, on any utility pole or on any tree, post, fence, flagstone, curbstone, sidewalk, or on any public property within the village.

Section 3.2 BILLBOARDS RESTRICTED

No person shall erect or maintain any billboard for the purpose of posting any handbills, posters, signs or advertisements of any kind on any of the streets or public places of this village except at such places and in such manner as shall be permitted by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3.3 BANNERS AND PENNANTS RESTRICTED

A. No person shall erect, install, suspend or hang a banner across a street within this village without first obtaining the approval of the Director of Public Works. Approval will not be given unless the location is satisfactory to the Director of Public Works and:

- 1) The banner is of satisfactory overall quality, as determined by the Director of Public Works, within his sole discretion.
- 2) The banner is no more than 44 inches wide and no more than 20 feet long.
- 3) The banner has adequate ventilation openings for wind pressure relief.
- 4) The banner has mounting rings not more than 24 inches apart on the top and bottom.
- 5) Anchoring points and methods are satisfactory to the Department of Public Works. If the banner is to be anchored to a building, or buildings, written consent(s) of the

building owner(s) shall be provided.

- 6) The proposed location is no closer than 100 feet to a traffic control light.
- 7) The banner's lowest point is not less than 21 feet above the pavement. Installation of approved banners shall be by or under the direction of the Department of Public Works.

B. No person shall erect, install, suspend or hang a pennant across a street within this village without first obtaining the approval of the Director of Public Works. Approval will not be given unless the location is satisfactory to the Director of Public Works and:

- 1) Anchoring points and methods are satisfactory to the Department of Public Works. If the pennant is to be anchored to a building, or buildings, written consent(s) of the building owner(s) shall be provided.
- 2) The proposed location is no closer than 100 feet to a traffic control light.
- 3) The pennant's lowest point is not less than 21 feet above the pavement. Installation of approved pennants shall be by or under the direction of the Department of Public Works.

C. Any banner or pennant which is damaged or ceases to comply with the conditions stated above shall be removed immediately. All banners and pennants shall be removed within seven days of the completion of the event which they were erected to celebrate. Removal shall be by or under the direction of the Department of Public Works.

Section 3.4 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any violation of this local law shall subject the person or persons violating the same to a penalty of not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) or more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense with each day being a separate offense.

Section 3.5 EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

A Local Law Regulating Advertising Matter

Adopted 5-25-36

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
WELLSVILLE, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3.1 POSTING PROHIBITED

No person shall post any handbills, notices or advertisements of any kind whatsoever, or print, paint, stamp or otherwise mark any words, letters, figures, signs or tokens, of any sort or kind, on any utility pole or on any tree, post, fence, flagstone, curbstone, sidewalk or on any public property within this village.

Section 3.2 BILLBOARDS RESTRICTED

No person shall erect or maintain any billboard for the purpose of posting any handbills, posters, signs or advertisements of any kind on any of the streets or public places of this village except at such places and in such manner as shall be permitted by the Board of Trustees.

Section 3.3 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Any violation of this ordinance shall subject the person or persons violating the same to a penalty of not less than three dollars(\$3.00) or more than five dollars(\$5.00) for each offense.
