A Local Law Authorizing The Conduction Of Bingo Games By Authorized Organizations Within The Territorial Limits Of The Village Of Wellsville.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLSVILLE, NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be lawful for any authorized organization, namely, a bona fide religious, charitable organization or bona fide educational, fraternal, civic, or service organization or a bona fide organization of veterans or voluntary firemen which by its charter, certificate of incorporation, constitution or act of the legislature, shall have among its dominate purposes one or more of the lawful purposes as defined in Section 476 (b) of the General Municipal Law, provided that each organization shall operate without profit to its members and provided that each organization has engaged in serving one or more of such lawful purposes for a period of one year immediately prior to obtaining a license to conduct games of bingo within the limits of the village of Wellsville under the provisions of this local law, the provisions of the Bingo Control and Licensing Laws of the State of New York and any amendments thereto.

Section 2. That the provisions of the Bingo Control and Licensing Laws of the State of New York control the licensing of organizations and the conduct of bingo games in the Village of Wellsville, and this local law incorporates the provisions of these statutes as if set forth in full herein. Any inconsistency between this local law and the said statutes shall be resolved in favor of those statutes.

Section 3. No game of chance shall be conducted under any licenses issued under this local law on the first day of the week, commonly known and designated as Sunday.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect April 1, 1975 in the event of approval of same by a majority of the qualified electors of the Village of Wellsville, voting on a proposition therefore duly submitted at a general or special election held within the Village of Wellsville, as provided by law.
