Local Law No. 2 of the year 1999

A local law for the purpose of delegating to the Chief of Police the power granted to the Mayor to request and grant police assistance.

Be it enacted by the BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the

Village of Wellsville as follows:

The purpose of this local law is to delegate to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Section 209-m of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request and grant police assistance.

Section 1. Content In accord with Section 209-m of the General Municipal Law of New York State there is delegated to the Chief of Police the powers granted to the Mayor under Section 209-m of the General Municipal Law of New York State to request and grant police assistance.

Section 2. Effective Date This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
