Local Law Number 1 of 1998

A local law amending the parking fines/structure for the Village

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wellsville as follows:

ARTICLE I

Article VI Section 35-10 (B) shall be amended to read:

The issuance of parking violations throughout the village where there are meters will be enacted during the hours of 9:00 am and 6:00 pm on Monday through Friday. During these specified days and hours a vehicle that is parked at an expired meter will be issued a two dollar (\$2.00) parking violations. If said vehicle remains at the same meter on the same day two (2) hours after the original ticket is issued, an additional ticket for twelve dollars (\$12.00) will be issued to said vehicle. If said vehicle remains at the same meter on the same day two (2) hours after the second ticket is issued, an additional ticket for twelve dollars (\$12.00) will be issued to said vehicle.

Of Sections 35-10-B, as amended the sum of \$2.00; if said violation is paid on or before the fifth business day following the issuance of the notice the \$2.00 must be paid, or the sum of \$15.00 if paid after the fifth day but on or before the 30th day following the issuance of such notice; as amended the sum of \$12.00; if said violation is paid on or before the fifth business day following the issuance of the notice the \$12.00 must be paid, or the sum of \$25.00 if paid after the fifth day but on or before the 30th day following the issuance of such notice; as amended the sum of \$12.00; if said violation is paid on or before the fifth business day following the issuance of the notice the \$12.00 must be paid, or the sum of \$25.00 if paid after the fifth day but on or before the 30th day following the issuance of the notice.

Of Sections 35-10 H shall read:the sum for satisfaction of said violation will be that established by the State of New York Department of Motor Vehicles and amended accordingly.

ARTICLE II

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State or June 1, 1998 whichever is later.
