The repair of the Madison Culvert is almost finished. Indeed by the time you receive this memo, the Culvert will be finished. If you happened to travel up Madison Hill while the repair was in progress, you would have noticed the debris and the collapsed conduit.

We are trying to locate an area within the Village limits to develop a composting area. Bill Whitfield (DPW director) and I checked the Lagoon for a possible location. If we do have a composting area, Bill suggested that a wood chipper be available because the Village does not pick up tree and bush trimmings.

The Village Trustees have voted to proceed with the purchase of the Former Citiz bank. An engineering firm has been contracted to study and recommend arrangement for the offices to be "housed" in the building. We will keep you posted on the progress.
