It is that time of the year, when leaves have to be raked from the lawns and the Village Street has to gather them so that the street water drains do not become plugged. Instruction for gathering the leaves is attached. Please make every effort to comply with this request.

The Communication (Dispatch) Center has been downgraded on a part time operation. This will decrease the cost significantly. However do not anticipate a significant decrease for the Village taxes. There are many improvements needed before the taxes can be reduced. New street signs, street improvements, and equipment to be replaced are a few the things that require attention before taxes can be reduced.

I intend to propose to the Village Trustees at the next session that the Village require the Town Council to pay rent for the use of our building. The Village residents contribute to the Town's taxes and receive very little in return. Whereas, the Town uses this building rent and service free.

Village of Wellsville **LEAF COLLECTION**

The Village of Wellsville Public Works Department is scheduled to begin leaf collection on October 18th and continue through November.

Residents are asked to follow guidelines listed below:

- 1. Rake the leaves to the edge of the street (tree lawn area between sidewalk and curb). If there is no tree lawn area, please rake the leaves to the property owner's side of the sidewalk.*

PLEASE DO NOT PUT IN THE STREET

- 2. Do not mix tree trimmings, brush trimmings, pumpkins, etc with leaves.*
