Place items at curbside with your household garbage no later than **6:00 am** on the day of pickup.

Weight limit of 50 lbs. per container.
 Container lids must be removable.
 No yard debris.

Recyclable material and solid waste are collected on the same day but in different vehicles and at different times.




G	GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS	Rinse Labels can be left on Remove lids and neck rings Separate by color	NO window glass, auto glass, mirrors, fluorescent bulbs, light bulbs, drinking glasses, dishes, pottery or ceramics. NO blue or white glass.
M	METAL CANS	Tin, steel, aluminum and bi-metal cans Rinse and remove labels	NO propane cylinders, aerosol, paint or fuel cans. NO cans with any kind of non-metal lining. NO alum. pie tins or foil.
P	PLASTIC CONTAINERS	Rinse out and remove lids Only plastic containers marked      	NO motor oil containers NO styrofoam or plastic bags.
N	NEWSPAPER / MAGAZINES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspapers including all inserts, colored or glossy papers and coupons • Magazines and catalogs • Telephone books and paperback books • Junk mail including envelopes • Computer paper, letterhead, copy paper, tablet, fax paper, greeting cards 	DO NOT recycle: manila folders, manila envelopes, or padded mailing envelopes. Discard any paper product coated with wax or contaminated with food.
C	CARDBOARD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrugated cardboard boxes • Single layered cardboard and box board including cereal boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes, etc. • Brown paper bags Protect from rain and wind	DO NOT recycle: milk cartons, juice boxes, waxed coated boxes, beer/soda containers, egg cartons, cardboard tubes, cones, white cardboard, or PIZZA BOXES.
